RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TE-MOAK TRIBE OF WESTERN SHOSHONE INDIANS OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION NO: 10-TM-11

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TE-MOAK TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE TE-MOAK TRIBE OF WESTERN SHOSHONE INDIANS OF NEVADA, THAT:

WHEREAS, this organization is a recognized Indian Organization as defined under the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934, as amended, and exercises rights of home rule and is responsible for the promotion of the economic and social welfare and well being of its members; and

WHEREAS, the Te-Moak Tribe is composed of four (4) constituent Bands, Elko, Battle, South Fork and Wells; and

WHEREAS, the Te-Moak Tribe recommends Betty Tippeconnie for the position of the Western Regional Director and second choice would be for Weldon "Bruce" Loudermilk.


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Te-Moak Tribe supports the candidacy of Betty Tippeconnie and second choice Weldon "Bruce" Loudermilk and strongly recommends the Department of the Interior to consider one of these candidates for the position of the Western Regional Director.
