RESOLUTION NO: 14-TM-09

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TE-MOAK TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE TE-MOAK TRIBE OF WESTERN SHOSHONE INDIANS OF NEVADA; THAT

WHEREAS, this organization is a recognized Indian Organization as defined under the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, as amended, to exercises certain rights of home rule and to be responsible for the promotion of economic and social welfare if its Tribal Members; and

WHEREAS, the Battle Mountain Council has requested the exclusion ordinance be enacted for the removal of Ruth Burton, non-Indian from the Battle Mountain Band Colony; and

WHEREAS, on a duly held meeting on April 15, 2014 the Te-Moak Tribe of Western Shoshone discussed the request.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, a hearing for Ruth Burton has been scheduled on May 19th at 5:00 p.m. at the Te-Moak Housing Authority Conference Room.


