RESOLUTION NO: 15-TM-17

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TE-MOAK TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE TE-MOAK TRIBE OF WESTERN SHOSHONE INDIANS OF NEVADA THAT:

WHEREAS, this organization is a recognized Indian Organization as defined under the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934, as amended, and exercises rights of home rule and is responsible for the promotion of the economic and social welfare and well-being of its members; **and**

WHEREAS, the Te-Moak Tribal Council is composed of four (4) constituent Bands, Elko, Battle Mountain, South Fork and Wells; **and**

WHEREAS, the Elko Band Council by Resolution No. 2014-EBC-05 indicates the Elko Band and the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) are preparing to construct BIA Road Project; EKIC 102 (4), Indian View Heights Drive, which requires BIA Right of Way; **and**

WHEREAS, The Elko Band Council by Resolution No. 2014-EBC-05 has proposed a paved portion, improvements, and project area for Indian View Heights, **and**

WHEREAS the Te-Moak Tribe has reviewed this proposal and approves as read.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Te-Moak Tribal Council supports the Elko Band Council and hereby approves and authorizes consent to the granting of a road Right of Way to the Federal Government, Bureau of Indian Affairs as identified as follows:


1. Right of Way, Drawing EK-102-3
2. A road Right of Way, 60 feet in width and 4239.52 feet in length within Section 10, T.34N., R55 E1, MDM contains 5.84+/- acres;

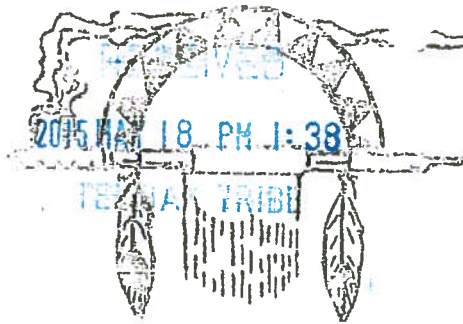

ELKO BAND COUNCIL

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE ELKO BAND COUNCIL

Resolution No. 2014-EBC-05

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ELKO BAND COUNCIL, that

WHEREAS, this organization is an Indian Organization known as the Elko Band Council as defined under the Indian Reorganization Act of June 1934, as amended, to exercise certain rights of home rule and to promote economic and the social welfare of its Tribal members; and

WHEREAS, the Elko Band Council is a Constituent Band of the Te-Moak Tribe of Western Shoshone Indians of Nevada, and is the governing body of the Elko Indian Colony; and

WHEREAS, the Elko Band Council has the obligation to protect and preserve the safety, welfare, and properties associated with the Elko Indian Colony members; and

WHEREAS, the Elko Band of the Te-Moak Tribe of Western Shoshone Indians and the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) are preparing to construct BIA Road Project: EKIC 102 (4), Indian view Heights Drive, which requires BIA Right-of-Way; and

WHEREAS, the proposed paved portion, improvements, and project area for Indian View Heights Road is 5.84+/- acres.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Elko Band Council hereby approves and authorizes consent to the granting of a road Right-of-Way to the Federal Government, Bureau of Indian Affairs as identified as follows:

1. Right-of-Way, Drawing #EK-102-3

A Road Right-of-Way, 60 feet in width and 4239.52 feet in length within Section 10, T.34N., R.55E., MDM, contains 5.84+/- acres;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Elko Band Council on behalf of the Elko Band, in order to move the construction of BIA Road Project: EKIC 102(4) forward in a timely manner, hereby waives appraisal and compensation on the proposed Right-of-Way, Drawing #EK-102-3; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Superintendent of the Eastern Nevada Agency is hereby requested to approve the Granting of Right-of-Way and any necessary Temporary Construction Easements needed, and upon completion of the BIA Road Project: EKIC 102(4),

the BIA is requested to add Rout 102, Indian View Heights Drive, to the Tribe's Roads Inventory (if not already applied); and


BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Elko Band Council authorizes the Chairman, Vice-Chairman or their designee to execute any and all documents necessary to facilitate the intent of this resolution.
